Thirty Something!

It rained on the IU - Michigan State football game Saturday, November 12, but not on Iota Delta's 30th Anniversary celebration! Alumni, wives, and sweethearts began arriving at the Four Seasons Inn in Nashville Friday evening for a reunion party lasting until dawn, including a serenade of Chi Phi songs led by Tom Shriner '69, Bill Nuss '68, Joe Goeller '63, and Rich Tandy '68. Saturday followed with a leisurely luncheon at the Chapter house and stadium tailgate party as the IU game did not begin until 3:30 in the afternoon.

The Old House and the New House were reunited for the Saturday evening banquet festivities at the Four Seasons. Charter members attending were Dr. Dick Altenhof '60, Mike Carter '62, Don Deganutti '60, Gayl Doster '60, Dave Engel '60, Jerry Hubner '59, Bill Mahl '62, Mel Rahe '60, and Chico Tinkle '60. The Fraternity was honored with the presence of Chancellor Herman B. Wells and Dr. Robert H. Schaffer, former Dean of Students. Dr. Wells, the grantor of Iota Delta's initial Charter, commented, "You've proven in these 30 years the wisdom of your chartering in the beginning!" After the invocation given by National Ritualistic Officer Frank Kovacs I '73, ID '83, Master of Ceremomies Rich Tandy introduced Alpha Mark Rappel '89 who reviewed the progress of the Chapter, noting that " the brotherhood of Chi Phi actives with those who have graduated is among the best anywhere!" John Craft '61 then awarded 25 Year pins to the following men: 1960 - Dr. Dick Altenhof, Mel Rahe; 1962 -Mike Carter, Tom Cook; 1963 - Joe Goeller, Gordon Gouveia, Dick Gribble; 1964 - Arnie Applegate, Dave Fosnough, Gene Johnson, Angie Kostas, Bill Montgomery, Dr. Ray Snapp, Tom Wilmore; and 1965 - Ed McClure. John observed that the 1965 through 1969 classes should begin their plans to be on hand for the 35th Anniversary.

Retiring Alumni President Doug Givan '82 recognized Dr. Perry Lopez and Randy McNutt with Distinguished Service Citations, while John Craft received a blazer emblazoned with the Chi Phi crest for his many services to the Fraternity. Among the over 400 people in attendance were some of the Brothers who helped

John Craft summarized the warmth of spirit, to immense applause, which animated the 30th Anniversary gathering. He stated, "The success of any organization is not in its leadership, but in the enthusiasm of individual members. I think the great group of guys we have had through the years will be a continuing source of strength to our Chapter. Thank you and we'll see you in five years, if not sooner." The evening and early Sunday morning celebration concluded to the strains of "Barbara Ann" by the Beach Boys. Iota Delta is hardly ready yet for "After the Ball is Over"!
