Spring/Summer RUSH



Iota Delta is approaching its 35th Anniversary in November 1993. Like many fraternities, it has experienced both good times and bad, but survives with expectations for an even better future. The Chapter living room contains many sports, campus activities, and educational awards, with our I.U. graduates including careers such as scientists, doctors, lawyers, business executives, and other prominent men. As of 1992, the Chapter does owe a mortgage of \$ 100,000, but this is little more than nominal compared to the price of private homes today. Nevertheless, Iota Delta has traditionally suffered from a shortage of funds. This is often due to a "roller coaster" Rush Program which fails to respond adequately to large graduating classes, such as losing 20 Seniors in May 1991.

On February 26, 1992, Bob Redell, Rush Co-Chairman with Brent Stern, reported that, "We have signed 10 guys for the early Spring Pledge class, with 4 Seniors graduating in May. Interest has been shown in running Summer Rush by Kirk Johanneson and Travis Britt. It is estimated that we will have 38 live-in's at the beginning of the Fall, excluding Summer Rush."

In his current Parents Club newsletter, Judge Ted Kowalski included a request which also applies to our nearly 600 alumni. Ted stated, "Iota Delta has a normal capacity to house 54 and even 60 men, if all available space is used. A 45 member house just meets normal expenses for utilities, food, and so on. If there are not enough members, active and living in the house, there is just not enough money to maintain the house properly and routine upkeep becomes a problem"
